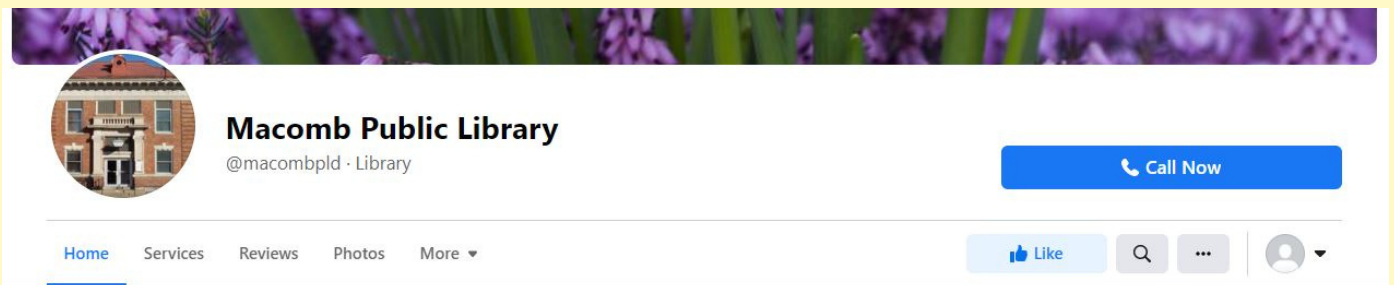
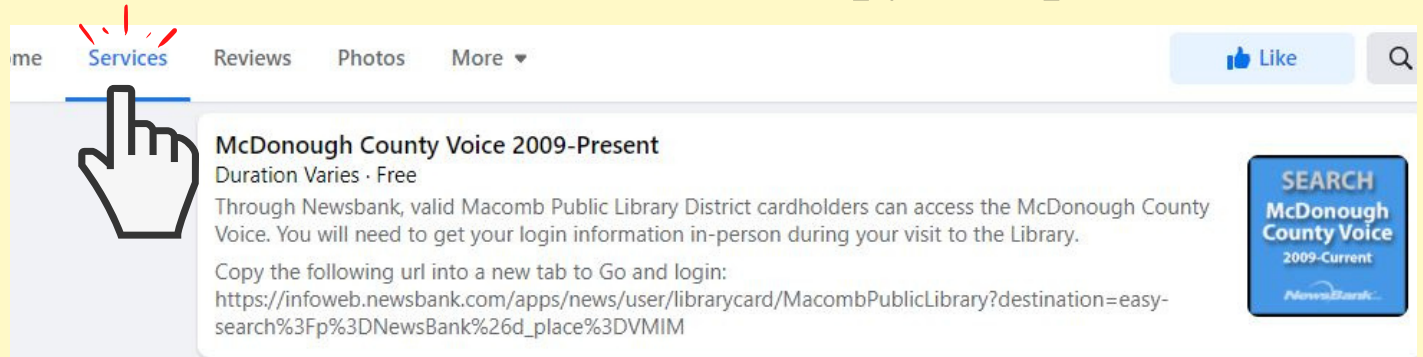


Macomb Public Library now offers Newsbank to all of our cardholders. Follow this tutorial to learn how to access all of their newspapers and magazines.

**Heritage Hub:** *Discover the premier collection of U.S. obituaries and death notices for genealogical research, 1704 - today.*

**U.S.A. Source Locator Map:** *An intuitive map-based interface to help you search the sources.*

**The McDonough County Voice (IL):** *Online text format of the local newspaper from 2009-current issue.*

**USA:** *Search more than 8,000 of online sources available from the United States.*

**America's News Magazines:** *Current content and deep archives from more than 3,650 U.S. news sources, it is useful for exploring a diverse range of popular topics including business, health, politics, careers, entrepreneurship and much more.*

**World:** *A combination of global, regional and local news, including a unique merging of news formats (full-text articles, web-only content, PDF image editions), this resource supports a diverse range of research needs across an array of academic disciplines for students and faculty.*
